

Education/Outreach Coordinator (Part Time)

Job Description:

Orchestra Miami is seeking a dynamic, motivated individual with a passion for serving the community through music to help Orchestra Miami successfully create and implement its education and outreach initiatives.

The Education/Outreach Coordinator for Orchestra Miami will focus on the following responsibilities:

- 1. Administering and overseeing the Orchestra Miami/Carnegie Hall Link Up program. These responsibilities include recruiting schools/teachers, serving as a liaison between Orchestra Miami, Carnegie Hall and the Miami-Dade County Public Schools, setting up and administering the Professional Development workshop for teachers, collecting and reporting data.
- 2. Planning and overseeing Free Family Concerts. These responsibilities include booking venues, overseeing the shows, collecting data from the audience
- 3. Planning, creating, overseeing and/or assisting with Orchestra Miami's outreach events
- 4. Creating study materials/parent guides for Orchestra Miami's Family Fun series
- 5. Representing Orchestra Miami at Education related events
- 6. Developing new opportunities for education/outreach within budgetary parameters

The Education/Outreach Coordinator will work closely with the Artistic Director (Elaine Rinaldi) to ensure that the artistic goals of the education and outreach programs and well-planned and accomplished.

Orchestra Miami currently has a small staff, comprised of a Manager of Social Media and Events (position open, a Manager of PR & Design, the Artistic Director and an Executive Director. Orchestra Miami's current annual budget is between \$450-\$500,000 per season.

- A Bachelor's degree in a related field (music, education, management)
- Familiarity with education standards for Miami-Dade County Public Schools
- Knowledge and understanding of the Miami community and nonprofit landscape

Salary: This is a part-time position with flexible hours. During the season, there will be more hours than off-season. Salary can be a flat monthly rate or per hour, with a maximum of \$19,500 per year. The Education/Outreach Coordinator position is an independent contractor position, with the person hired being responsible for their own taxes.
